## Our Mission

The ADVANTAGES DLS mission is to assist all learners on their path to a high-quality education by providing tools and resources to personalize learning both locally and abroad. ## Curriculum

Advantages School International (ASI) is fully accredited for grades K-12. The school offers comprehensive grade level subjects for each grade with a wide variety of electives, Honors, and Advanced Placement and World Languages courses for the higher-grade levels. ASI also offers credit recovery, Career and Technical Courses and test preparation courses for students needing even more.

For high school students seeking a US high school diploma ASI offer two tracks, General Education and College Preparatory.

The College **Prep Track** comprises of 20 credits in the following disbursement: English (4); mathematics (4); science (3); social science (3) including US History (.5), US Government (.5); Physical Education (1.5); Health (.5); Visual and Performing Arts (1); World Languages (2); Elective (1).

The **General Education Track** comprises of 13 credits in the following disbursement: English (3); mathematics (2); science (2); social science (3) including US History (.5), US Government (.5); Physical Education (1.5); Health (.5); Visual and Performing Arts (1)

Advantages School offers over 28 Advanced Placement courses and over 17 Honors courses.

## Grading and Ranking

Advantages School International assigns letter grades using a 4.0 system and has adopted the following grading scale: A=93-100%; A-=90-92%; B+=88-89%; B=83-87%; B-=80-82%; C+=78-79%; C=73-77%; C-=70-72%; D+=68-69%; D=63-67%; D-=60-62; F=0-59%.

All credited classes are included in computing grade point average. Advantages School International does not calculate class rank.
