



Credit-By-Exam Offerings

Exams are proctored virtually, students test from home.

WHAT IS CREDIT-BY-EXAM (CBE)?

Students can earn credit for courses in which they demonstrate mastery of course material by taking the course exam(s). ASI offers a variety of options for CBE.

CBE does not satisfy the NCAA core course requirement.

- Tests can only be taken one time per subject.
- All exams are computer-based and will be taken online.
- CBEs are not considered Honors credit.
- Students must earn a 70% on the CBE to earn credit.
- Grades are posted with the letter grade to reflect the percentage scored.
- Failed tests are not posted to the student's transcript.

COURSES AVAILABLE FOR CBE

- **Mathematics:** Pre-Algebra, Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry
- **Social Studies:** US Government & Economics, US History, World History
- **English/Language Arts:** English 9, English 10, English 11, and English 12
- **World Languages:** Spanish I, Spanish II, French I, French II

SCHEDULING FOR CBE

Students can request a CBE through their success manager. Exams are proctored. You will need the following to take the exam:

- Webcam with audio is mandatory
- Use Google Chrome - no other browser will work
- Have a Picture ID - School ID or other government ID
